Moreover, such participation of the above activity should be on a voluntary basis and is on personal time and expense.

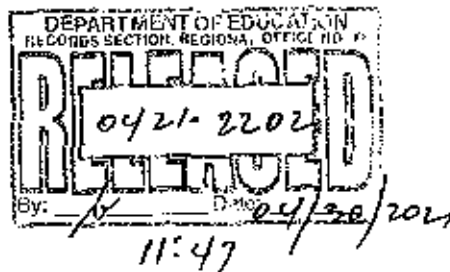

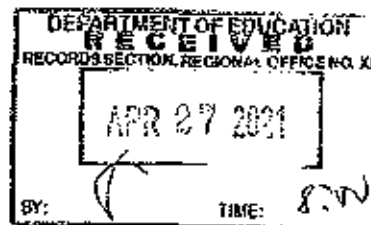
