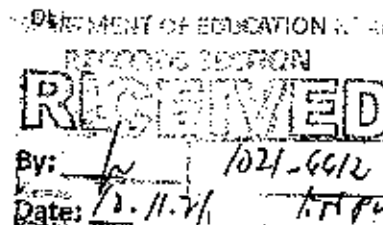



## Online QUIZ BEE

### Participants:

- It is open to junior or senior high students who are presently enrolled in any of the schools located in the Davao Region.
- He/she must show proof of his/her enrollment by presenting a certification from the school that he/she is enrolled for this school year and his grade level.
- He/she must have a strong internet connection with 3mb download and upload speed.
- He/she must be able to maintain a clear video and audio during the event.
- Family and relatives of DTI-XI employees are not allowed to join.

### Mechanics:

The game shall be conducted in the zoom conferencing platform.

All participants shall be required to open their video and microphone during the session.

There will be three rounds: Easy, Average and Difficult. A clincher or a sudden death round shall be done in cases that there would be a tie.

Coaching and cheating is strictly prohibited.

Easy Round – 15 questions (multiple choice questions)

Average Round – 10 questions (identification)

Difficult Round - 10 questions (identification)

### For the Easy Round:

- The contestants shall be brought to the breakout room where they will be required to answer fifteen (15) multiple choice questions.
- The questions will appear on the screen and shall be read once by the host and the contestant will be given ten (10) seconds to answer.
- The question will be read twice. The contestants will answer in a clean sheet of paper and show their answers.
- Participants will not raise or show their answers before the time ends. They will be asked to raise their answers.
- Moderators will check and tally the correct answers. Participants will lower their answers only when the host asks them.
- The correct answers of each contestant shall be automatically be calculated by the system. The fifteen (15) highest score shall move on to the Average round.

### For the Average Round:

- The remaining fifteen contestants shall continue and answer ten (10) identification questions. They should secure a clean sheet of paper in their table and a black marker. They will be given fifteen (15) seconds to answer.
- The question will be read twice. The contestants will answer in a clean sheet of paper and show their answers.
- Participants will not raise or show their answers before the time ends. They will be asked to raise their answers.

REGION 11 (DAVAO REGION)

- Moderators will check and tally the correct answers. Participants will lower their answers only when the host asks them.
- The question will be read twice and the contestant shall keep their answers until the host would ask to raise the answer. The answers must be clear and legible. Moderators will check if the contestants give the correct answers.
- The score will be tallied and the five (5) contestant with the highest score shall move on to the Difficult Round.

**For the Difficult Round:**

- The top five (5) highest score shall be pin in the screen.
- The question will be read twice. The contestants will answer in a clean sheet of paper and show their answers.
- Participants will not raise or show their answers before the time ends. They will be asked to raise their answers.
- Moderators will check and tally the correct answers. Participants will lower their answers only when the host asks them.
- The contestant with the highest score shall be declared as the winner.

**In case of a tie:**

- A sudden death Round shall be conducted.
- The contestant who gets the correct answer shall be declared the winner.

**In case of a protest:**

- The participant must immediately inform any of the moderator if he/she has any protest.
- The issue protested will be settled immediately by the moderators.
