This is in reference to the Unnumbered Memorandum from **ALLAN FARNAZO**, Director IV, Department of Education, Office of the Regional Director ROXI issued on March 17, 2022 re **ENDORSEMENT OF THE 2022 WINS Massive Open Online Courses (MOOC)**. The Office the Undersecretary for Administration (OUA) through the Bureau of Learners Support Services – School Health Division (BLSS-SHD) will conduct the Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH) in Schools (WinS) Massive Open Online Courses (MOOC) in two batches this year as part of the Department of Education’s response to Covid 19 through capacity building of personnel. These MOOC’s shall be composed of the Leading WinS and Accelerating WinS which aim to accelerate the improvement of WASH status in schools. The two self-paced WinS MOOC courses will be offered for school level participants for Leading WinS and division personnel for Accelerating WinS.
2. The implementation of this virtual capacity building initiatives is required in meeting the minimum health standards and ensuring the proper hygiene can be practiced by learners and DepEd personnel in the current situation and once schools reopen at some point in the future. This is in accordance to DepEd Order No.14 s. 2020.


