- SHS Grade 11 Report Card - Form 138 (at least 85% GWA)
- Portfolio of Involvement in Sports/Dance

Applicants who will pass the initial screening will undergo another set of screening measures such as Sports Skill Testing (SST), the Sports Readiness Test (SRT), a Guidance Test, and a Panel Interview before they can be accepted to the program. These tests are necessary to determine if they will be able to meet the demands of the degree course.
