

The Season 31 of the PSC — PATAFA Weekly Relay will be held at the Philsports Track and Field Oval in Pasig City starting this July. This season, we intend to hold this grass root program nationwide for young athletes who want to engage in the sport of Athletics. We have advised our PATAFA Regional Directors to organize the same program in their region and we intend to launch the games simultaneously on July 3. The qualifiers in this region will have the chance to compete in the national finals on November 5 and 6 at the Philsports Track and Field Oval in Pasig City, NCR.


