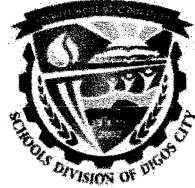

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Registration Fee:

A registration fee of P3,500 will be charged per participant to cover speakers’ honorarium and airfare, seminar bag, handouts, certificate, 2 lunches and 4 snacks. A discount of P200 will be given to early registrants and students and P300 to PACAE members and undergraduate students. **Accommodation is not included in the registration fee.** Accommodation inside the Teachers Camp, Baguio City is P180.00 pax/day while in other cities very affordable accommodations which are near the venue will be recommended by the organizer.
