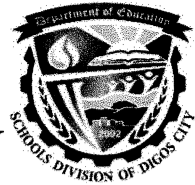

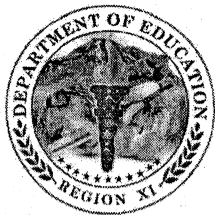

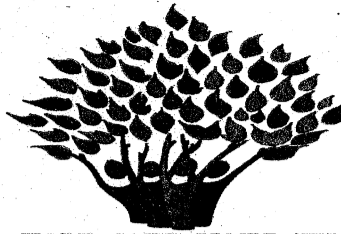
The target participants are special education (SPED) teachers and school administrators from both public and private schools.


