SUBJECT : 2017 NATIONAL SCIENCE CLUB MONTH (NSCM) CELEBRATION

TO : Regional Directors
 Schools Division/City Superintendents
 Heads, Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Schools

1. The Philippine Society of Youth Science Clubs Inc. (PSYSC) is a national organization that supports science education through effective learning materials and interactive activities for students and teachers. It promotes Public Understanding of Science, Technology, and Environment (PUSTE).
2. September has been declared as the National Science Club Month, an in pursuant with Presidential Proclamation No. 264, PSYSC together with the DOST and DepEd are enjoined to hold activities in celebration of NSCM.
3. Cognizant to the significance of the youth to promote PUSTE, PSYSC announces its activities for the upcoming NSCM and aims:
 - a. To provide a venue for learning science, technology and environment outside the four walls of the classroom.
 - b. To foster camaraderie and develop leadership skills among the Science Clubbers
 - c. To encourage active participation in the National Science Club Month and hence, the Science Clubbing Movement.
4. As part of the PSYSC's involvement in the said celebration, the PSYSC announces the *National Science Clubs Summit*, a mini-camp for high school students; the *PSYSC Science Olympiad*, a quiz competition for both elementary and high school; the *I Teach Science Seminar* is a half-day seminar for teachers; and the *MathSciaKa*, an engineering science competition for elementary and high school students both in public and private.
5. The *National Science Clubs Summit* together with the *I Teach Science Seminar* will be held on September 9-10, 2017 at Pantukan National High School, Pantukan, Compostela Valley.
6. The PSYSC Science Olympiad National Eliminations will be on September 9, 2017 and will be held at Pantukan National High School, Pantukan, Compostela Valley. The National Finals will be held on September 30, 2017 in the National Capital Region.
7. The *MathsciaKa* is a Luzon-based activity and will be held on September 23, 2017 in the National Capital Region.
