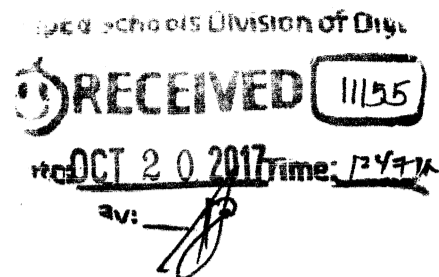

Greetings! I am inviting art teachers and those who have inclinations in the creative arts particularly dance, theater arts, music and visual arts to join the five(5)-day art training teachers, dubbed as HULMA: CREYARD ART Training for Teachers on November 30 until December 4, 2017 to be held at the Southwill Learning Center. This project is in collaboration with the National Commission of Culture and the Arts to be facilitated by experts and art practitioners from University of the Philippines, University of Victoria, and other art communities of the country.

General Objective of the training workshop:


- To enlarge the teaching repertoire of the participants by developing instructional models for every art instruction: music, dance, visual arts, and theater arts.

In order to achieve the general objective, the teacher participants should be able to:

- Exercise the exploratory process of creative improvisation on different art forms
- Relate various learning theories to the instructional context of the teacher participants.
- Explore instructional problems and solutions in the creative process of the art workshops and assess how these practices viable to the instructional context.
- Create various expressions as a product of the creative instructions
- Produce creative outputs that are strongly grounded with the limitations of the instructional context

The target participants are teachers in Literature, Filipino, English, Physical Education, Music, Arts, Creative Writing, Humanities. Teacher-participants are clustered according to field of interests: theater arts, dance, music, & visual arts. For every cluster or group there are only 10 participants. The training and workshop fee for five days including training kits, meals (breakfast, snacks, & lunch), and creative production & installation exhibit is three thousand pesos PhP 3,000.
