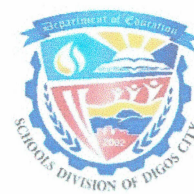



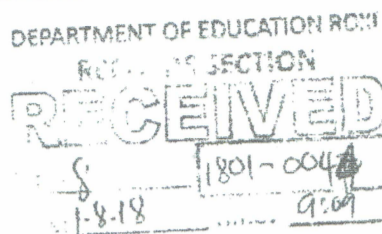

The training aims to enhance the knowledge, understanding and application by participants of the K - 12 standards particularly in content, process, assessment and supervision. This will capacitate them in the preparation and implementation of K to 12-aligned unit and learning plans and objectives. Inputs on classroom supervision will also be included.

Complete participation in all the sessions equivalent to thirteen (13) contact hours for two (2) days is a must to earn 13.5 CPD points. Attendance in less than 13 hours will only be given a certificate of attendance without any CPD points.

If possible, participants are encouraged to bring laptops with copies of the DEPED Curriculum Guides for all subjects.

As we have limited seats (100 only), reservations will be strictly by first-come-first-served basis. Pre-registration is expected as no walk-in participants will be admitted. Those who cannot be accommodated in this first series will be prioritized in the succeeding runs of the CPD training. See attached updated programs which also indicate upcoming schedule.
