- 1. The Digos City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council headed by Atty. Einstein Garry R. Taghoy and the Division DRRM Focal Person have agreed for the conduct of a 3-day training and orientation for the purpose of raising public awareness regarding DRR and to strengthen the capacity of school-based DRRM Council to respond effectively to climate and other natural and human-induced hazards and disasters.
- The training will be on October 29, 2015 and November 7-8, 2015 respectively at Ramon Magsaysay Central Elem. School covered court from 8:00 in the morning to 5:00 in the afternoon.
- 3. For the school level, the participants of this training will be five (5) Teachers from each school who have organized their School Disaster Action Team.
 - 4. Registration is free and participants will have two (2) snacks and one (1) meal per day.
- 5. Teachers who will join the training on a weekend will earn Service Credits for the hours rendered with reference to Section d of DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 in granting service credits, to wit: "Attendance participation in special DepEd projects and activities which are short in duration....if such are held during the summer vacation or during weekends.
- Division Personnel who will attend on a weekend will earn Compensatory Overtime Credit (COC) for the hours rendered.
