- The Department of Health Region XI in coordination with the Department of Education Region XI successfully conducted the National School Deworming Day (NSDD 1) on July 29, 2015. Region XI ranked fourth with an accomplishment of 93%.
- 2. Attached is DepED Memorandum No. 156 s. 2015, entitled "Second Round of National School Deworming Day" (NSDD 2) for School Year 2015-206 which will be conducted on January 27, 2015.
- 3. The School-Based Combined Mass Drug Administration for Non-Schistosomiasis endemic schools will be given to children ages 5-12 years old (Kinder to Grade 6), while in the Schistosomiasis endemic schools ages 5-12 years old (Kinder- Grade 6) and Grade 7-10 students will be included.
- 4. It should be ensured that all school children should be fed prior to the administration of the deworming drugs. Holding area in every school must be designated and made available to accommodate cases of adverse events following actual intake of deworming medicines or drug administration. First aid medication for adverse events should likewise be available in the schools.
