LINTUNGANAY 2016

Lintunganay is a Cebuano term which, translated to Tagalog, means *orihinal*. And this perfectly encapsulates what the organization aims to create with this activity, especially with our new event, I-Guhit. Both competitions, I-Spell-Eng and I-Guhit, were created in accordance with the organization's literacy advocacy.

I-SPELL-ENG

I-SPELL-ENG is the highlight activity of the UP Omega Alpha Sorority, which aims to gather the best spellers in Mindanao, promote camaraderie among the participants, and establish linkages among different schools. We find that this as an excellent opportunity to introduce our organization and promote the University of the Philippines Mindanao as well. This competition is open to any junior high school student from any private or public school.

I-GUHIT

I-GUHIT is a fairly new activity of the UP Omega Alpha Sorority, this year being its launching. The aim of the event, an on-the-spot poster making competition, is to invite creative and talented students from all over Mindanao to share their vision concerning the promotion of literacy in the country. This event is also going to be used to promote BEAM-ARMM's program, *LIBRO Para sa Batang Bangsamoro*, which is a book donation drive that will benefit schoolchildren in the Autonomous Region of Muslim Mindanao (ARMM).
