- 1. The Department of Digos City Division will conduct the IPEd Planning Activity of the Division and Schools with IP Learners on February 12, 2016, from 8:00am to 5:00pm, at the Nakayama Function Center, Mabini-Bataan Streets, Digos City.

- 4. School heads are advised to assign an Officer-In-Charge who will look after the school during their attendance to the activity. Classes of those teachers attending the activity should also be arranged in such a way that teachers who are in attendance thereof will prepare their lesson plans and instructional materials to be given to the teachers who will take charge of their respective classes.
