- 5. All expenses relative to board and lodging of the participants. honoraria of resource nersons (Academic Track only), supplies and materials/ Training kits, Administrative Cost, and travelling expenses (trainers and management only) shall be charged against the downloaded Funds for the Grade 11 Training of Teachers while the travel from the station to the training venue and other incidental expenses of the participants (Grade 11 teachers) shall be charged local funds, all subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 6. This Office reiterates that the participants are to observe the following:
 - a. Report to the training venue on time.
 - b. First meal shall be breakfast on Friday while the last meal shall be dinner on Sunday
 - c. Attend the Opening Program on June 17, 2016 at 7:30 am and all sessions on time: Those who will fail to attend the Opening Program shall not be accepted. Early leavers and those who fail to submit their output shall only receive certificate of appearance. For those who cannot complete the training shall pay the corresponding the amount intended for the training allocation.
 - d. Present their authority to travel signed by the Schools Division Superintendent.
 - e. Bring their own laptops to the activity.
 - f. Come in proper attire and observe proper decorum throughout the duration of the training.
- 7. The participants and trainers shall be entitled to service credits for training days which fall on Saturdays and Sundays in accordance with DepED Order No. 53, s. 22003 entitled: Updated Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers.
