Please re-visit and adhere to DepEd Order No.8, s.2007 re: School Canteen Implementation Guidelines.

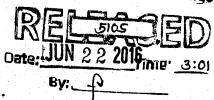
#### 4. DENGUE VECTOR SURVEILLANCE IN SCHOOL

# FOOD AND DRINKS TO BE SOLD IN THE SCHOOL CANTEENS

- Fruits in season and vegetable from reputable suppliers
- Cooked Foods- prepared and cooked in the school canteen or reputable suppliers
  - Vegetable Recipes
  - Hot Soup
  - One dish Meal
  - Banana (saba)
  - Corn
  - Root Crops
  - Native Delicacies
  - Peanuts
  - Rice
  - Viand (Nutritious and affordable)
  - Pancit bihon/canton
  - Pork and Chicken BBQ
  - Siomai
  - Siopao
  - Sandwiches with Nutritious filling (processed filling are discouraged)
- Juices and Beverages prepared in the school canteen or from reputable suppliers
  - Fresh fruit juices and shakes
  - Safe bottled water
  - Yogurt
  - Milk and Milk Products
- Freshly Baked Breads from reputable bakeries
  - Biscuits
  - Cakes, Mamon, Muffins
  - Cupcakes, Tostado, Biscocho

## FOOD AND DRINKS THAT ARE PROHIBITED IN SCHOOL CANTEENS

- Carbonated drinks
  - Softdrinks are prohibited as per DepED Order No. 8 s. 2007
- Softdrinks sold to teachers are prohibited

- Note: Please be guided that ready to eat foods that are sold in the canteen must not be salty, fatty or too sweet and expiry dates must be noted at all times.
