TO : Schools Division Superintendents

- In line with the implementation of the K to 12 Basic Education Program to support learners' holistic development on becoming effective lifelong learners with 21st century skills and to enhance the content of the curriculum and the methods and materials associated with it, a 3 – Day Seminar, Workshop and Writeshop on Addressing Performance Gaps of the Students in Science and Mathematics will be conducted on October 27, 28, and 29, 2016 at the Diamond Hall, NEAP, DepED RO XI, Quirino Street, Davao City.
- The activity aims to revisit and identify competencies in Science and Mathematics lessons that need to be unfolded by means of interventions; develop authentic assessment tools and contextualized learning materials that will enhance the content of Science and Mathematics curriculum under the K to 12 Program; and design teaching strategies integrating inquiry based localized materials as visual aids in the teaching and learning process in Science and Mathematics.
- Participants in this activity are Science and Mathematics teachers from elementary, junior and senior high schools who are proactive and result oriented. They are required to bring 20 sets of a 50-item multiple choice test paper answered by the students, laptop, USB and pocket wifi.
