Developmentally Appropriate Practices Workshop

To: Schools Division Superintendents

- 1. Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 12, s. 2015, entitled "Guidelines on the Early Language, Literacy and Numeracy Program: Professional Development Components". the Department of Education Regional Office XI will conduct a 7-Day Regional Roll-out on Developmentally Appropriate Practices (DAP) training on Early Language, Literacy and Numeracy on January 11-17, 2017-(First Batch), January 18-24, 2017 (Second Batch) and February 1-7, 2017 (Third Batch) at My Hotel, San Pedro Street, Davao City. Trainers and facilitators are expected to be at the venue on January 10, 2017 at 8:00 AM.
- 2. The objectives of this training are the following:
 - a) reinforce the capacity of kinder to Grade 3 teachers to teach and assess early reading and numeracy skills:
 - b) strengthen the skills of school heads as instructional managers and supervisors; and
 - c) improve management and administration of the program (i.e. planning, operations, action research, sharing, and implementing best practices, monitoring and networking).
- 3 The participants in this training will be one (1) K to 3 Teachers and one (1) School Head from each school that undergone the ELLN training as the workshop is a follow through of the previous training. Please refer to the attached sheet for the allocation per Division.
- 4. School Heads are advised to bring portable **Hard Drive Disk** or Laptop (with still more spaces) for the storage of videos to be used in their respective school-based training program. School Heads also are advised to assign an Officer-In-Charge who will look after the school in times of their attendance to the said training, Likewise, the teacher-participants will prepare activities for the class enough for the duration to be supervised by a teacher who will be assigned to take charge of the class.
- 5. Participants shall be granted with Compensatory Overtime Credits (COC) for attending training dates that will fall on Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays.
- 6. Food, accommodation, training resource materials and travelling expenses of the trainers shall be charged to 2016 ECARP Funds, while the travelling expenses of the participants shall be charged against local funds, all subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
