- 1. Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum No. 217, s. 2016 re: Screening, Selection, and Regional Cluster Training-Workshops of Potential Learning Resource Evaluators, this Division shall conduct the Screening and Selection of Potential Learning Resource Evaluators (LREs).
- 2. This activity is in preparation for the evaluation of learning resources, such as textbooks, teachers' manuals and supplementary materials for learning areas in the four key stages of learning, namely: (a) Kindergarten to Grade 3; (b) Grades 4 to 6; (c) Grades 7 to 10; and (d) Grades 11 and 12.
- 3. Individuals coming from both public and private sectors, who are deemed qualified based in the Criteria for the LREs for different learning areas and grade levels, must submit the documents listed below to the Record's Section of the Division Office on March 20, 2017 (Deadline of Submission of the Pertinent Papers):
  - a. Application Letter signifying interest to serve as LREs;
  - b. Duly accomplished Personal Data Sheet for Potential LREs found in Enclosure No. 2;
  - c. Curriculum Vitae; and
  - d. Other pertinent documents such as certified true copies of service records, transcript of record, certificates of relevant trainings attended since 2010, among others (original documents to be shown later for authentication during the scheduled interview).
