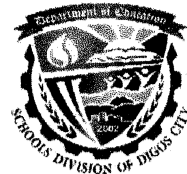

**AUGMENTATION OF SCHOOL SUPPLIES FOR MARAWI CITY INCIDENT
AFFECTED SCHOOL CHILDREN**

TO: CID and SGOD Chiefs
Public Schools District Supervisors
Elementary, Junior and Senior High School Heads
School Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Coordinators

1. In any disasters natural or human-induced, children are the most vulnerable. The Marawi City incident erupted last May 23, 2017 that causes thousands of civilians displaced. In addition, disruption of classes, lost of lives and properties are experienced by the people of Marawi City.
2. The Department of Education wants to ensure the learning continuity of our learners and to immediately restore normalcy of classes in the affected areas.
3. In line with this, the Department of Education, Region XI as part of the Mindanao Cluster is requesting assistance in augmentation of school supplies for the school children affected.
4. It is requested that the augmentation of school supplies shall be shared by each district/school. For this, all District Supervisors are enjoined to take the leadership in facilitating the collection/accumulation of sets of school supplies requested.
5. Attached are the list of items, total number of school supplies for each district/school, and the Regional Memorandum Number 156, s. 2017 entitled "Augmentation of School Supplies for Marawi City Incident Affected School Children", signed by Atty. Alberto T. Escobarte, CESO III, Regional Director, dated June 19, 2017.
6. School supplies per district/school must be delivered to the Division Office, attention: Reyzen O. Monserate, PDO II on or before July 17, 2017.
7. Wide and prompt dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
