1. This refers to the conduct of the 2017 Training-workshop on Contextualizing Support Systems for Indigenous Peoples Education (Batches 1 - 4) with the following schedule:

Cluster A - Batch 2: CAR (except Divisions of Abra and Apayao), III, VI, and NIR	May 29 - June 02, 2017	Mt. Province (exact venue to be announced)
Cluster B - Batch 3: V, VII, IX, and X	July 31 - August 04, 2017	South Cotabato (exact venue to be announced)
Cluster B - Batch 4: VIII, XI, XII, and XIII	August 07 - 11, 2017	South Cotabato (exact venue to be announced)

2. The Enhanced Basic Education Program, as stipulated in Republic Act No. 10533 and the IPEd provision of its Implementing Rules and Regulations (Sec. 8.4), mandates DepEd to develop a curriculum that is culture-sensitive, contextualized, and flexible enough to enable and allow schools to localize,

indigenize, and enhance based on the specific educational and social context of communities.

3. In 2015 and 2016, Regional and Division IPEd Focal Persons, and the chiefs of the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) and Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) were trained in the process of indigenizing the basic education curriculum in partnership with indigenous peoples (IP) communities. The indigenized curriculum serves as the basis for developing indigenized lesson plans and facilitating a culture-based and culture-responsive teaching-learning process at the school level.
4. To provide the necessary support in the implementation of the indigenized lesson plans which shall commence nationwide in School Year 2017-2018, the subject training-workshop shall be conducted to build the capacity of the chiefs of the Schools Governance and Operations Division (SGOD) and Education Support Systems Division (ESSD) and Regional and Division Indigenous Peoples Education (IPEd) Focal persons in responding to governance issues and concerns.
5. During the training-workshop, the participants are expected to:
 - a) discuss the legal and policy basis of the IPEd Program including foundational concepts that guide program implementation;
 - b) discuss the accountabilities and functions of the SGOD in relation to the process of IPEd implementation;
 - c) identify the key governance issues and concerns that need to be addressed in support of curriculum contextualization for IPEd;
 - d) analyze the governance issues and concerns raised, and discuss appropriate interventions;
 - e) discuss and give feedback regarding policies supportive of governance concerns in IPEd implementation;
 - f) design tools as needed for SGOD concerns; and
 - g) formulate an action plan specific on governance concerns in IPEd implementation.
