2. The Special Order shall be issued by this Regional Office separately to each of the school implementers. Concerned schools are reminded to keep the permit posted/displayed in a strategic place for information of all concerned.

3. Private schools implementing the program are directed to upgrade their modules and align with the K to 12 curriculum of the Department of Education subject to the validation by this Regional Office.

4. This re-accreditation shall be subject to revocation anytime the school fails to comply with the curriculum standards required for this program and to faithfully follow all the laws and the rules and regulations of the Department of Education.


5. The school authorities shall inform this Regional Office of any plan or action regarding voluntary closure of the program implementation, provided such closure is undertaken at the end of a school term, and provided further that the school remains obliged to furnish the necessary transfer credentials and records of the students affected by the closure.

6. It is stipulated, moreover, that the re-accreditation hereby granted does not extend to any branch or extension, whether located in the same municipality or city or in other municipalities within the region without prior approval by Department of Education.

7. That the students who will be admitted to the program shall be those who are presently working and whose age is over the normal age of a regular students.

8. All program implementers are hereby advised to submit accomplishment report every end of the school year, attention: Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD).
