To ensure the continuity of the implementation of DepEd Order No.16, s. 2012, entitled *Guidelines of the Implementation of the Mother Tongue- Based-Multi Lingual Education (MTB-MLE)*, the Bureau of Learning Delivery- Teaching and Learning Division (BLD-TLD) will conduct the First National Conference on MTB-MLE. This will be held on August 2-4 at Mariveles, Bataan.
