INTENSIFYING REGIONAL READING PROGRAM IMPLEMENTATION

To: Schools Division Superintendents

- 1. In adherence to the thrust of K to 12 to make each child a reader by Grade 3 through "Every Child A Reader Program" (ECARP) via Early Language Literacy and Numeracy, Region XI shall intensify its Reading Program implementation in every School in all levels.
- Each school is highly encouraged to have its Reading Program, following these components;
 - Reading Profile of all the learners per class
 - Intervention/ Enhancement Plan per class
 - Availability of Suitable Reading Materials
 - Tracking System/Record of Learner's Progress
 - Learner's Portfolio on Reading Activity Outputs
 - Final Reading Assessment Result
- 3. For Grades 3 to 6, there shall be a reading program per classroom while a pull out session per level shall be done for Grades 7 10 for at least one hour per week per learner.
- 4. All schools shall keep track the implementation of the program for sustainability. The result and observation of its implementation shall be one of the basis for the SLAC sessions.
- 5. The Reading Program Implementation shall be included in the School Implementation Plan (SIP), Annual Implementation Plan (AIP), and Annual Procurement Plan (APP) to support teachers made learner's materials and other related expenses.

- 6. To monitor and supervise its implementation, this office is providing a monitoring tool (to be released during the orientation). The findings and monitoring results shall be a basis for further technical assistance.
- 7. Starting School Year 2017-2018 onwards, this office shall identify a school for the Most Functional Reading Program for Elementary and for Junior High School.
- 8. To establish the norms and standards of the implementation of the program there shall be a 2-Day Regional Orientation and Workshop on September 4 to 5, 2017 at the Ano View Hotel, Camus St., Davao City,
