Basketball League for the World Teacher's Day 2017

- 1. The field is hereby informed that there will be a Basketball League for Male teachers and regular employees of this division. It will start on Tuesday, September 12, 2017 and will end on October 3, 2017 (T-Th Schedule) at the City Gymnasium, Jose Abad Santos St., Zone III, Digos City.
- 2. Four (4) teams will be competing with a minimum of ten (10) and a maximum of fifteen (15) players, namely: (1) Digos City National High School. (2) Division Office / SHS, (3) Digos Oriental District and (4) Digos Occidental /Mt. Apo Districts.
- 3. A registration fee of One Thousand Five Hundred pesos (Php 1,500.00) to cover the Referees' fee in every game, rental for the playing venue, and incidental expenses relative to the conduct of this league. No registration, No play Policy.
- 4. Schedule of the Games: A total of fourteen (14) games wherein two games per day is scheduled during the elimination round, a double round robin, and the Championship game, to wit:

5. Color coding. It is advised that the teams should observe the color of the team, to wit:

*DICNHS - Blue

*Division Office / SHS - Red

*Division Office - Yellow / Black

*Digos Occidental / Mt. Apo - Violet/Black

6. House Rules:

- a) The League adopts the Passarelle Rules (Modified).
- b) The first game will start at 7:30PM.
- c) A Ten (10) minutes playing time per quarter.
- d) Fifteen (15) minutes defaulting time for incomplete players.
- e) At least four (4) players should be around so that the 1st quarter game can start with a penalty points of 10.
- f) Each team should assign two (2) table administrators per game for the nonplaying team to take charge as time keeper, board scorer, score sheet in charge, and an announcer.

The Passarelle Rules: Modified and Adopted during the conduct of the Basketball League in celebration of the WORLD TEACHER'S DAY 2017.

- 1. Each team must consist of a minimum of 10 players and a maximum of 15, one of whom shall be Captain. Ten players should be nominated for each game. However, the whole squad should be entered on the scoresheet.
- 2. If a team does not start the game with 10 players their opponents shall automatically be awarded 10 points for each player, below 10, i.e. 9 players, 10 points start for the opposition.
- 3. The first half will consist of 4 x 5 minute periods, with an interval of 1 minute between each period.
- 4. Teams shall be entitled to one time out each ten minute period.
- 5. Each player will remain a substitute for two of the periods in the first half; i.e. each player will play for 2 x 5 minute periods in the first half.
- 6. No substitutions are allowed in the first half, except to replace a player who is injured, disqualified or has committed five fouls.
- 7. If a player is injured, disqualified or has committed five fouls in the first half, then the opposing coach may choose, if they so wish, a replacement player from the reserves (No. 11 and 12). If the team has only 10 players then the replacement must come from the substitutes. The time played by the substitute must be recorded and subtracted from the time they are allowed to play in the second half of the match.
- 8. Any clarification of the above rules should be addressed to the WTD 2017 Basketball League Committee.
