1. This refers to the subject workshop to be conducted by the DepEd - Indigenous Peoples Education Office (IPsEO) with the following schedule:

2. Consistent with the policy directive of the National IPEd Policy Framework (DepEd Order No. 62, s. 2011) to 'adopt appropriate basic education pedagogy, content and assessment through the integration of Indigenous Knowledge Systems and Practices (IKSPs) in all learning areas and processes', IPsEO has initiated the process of contextualizing lesson plans in Kindergarten and Grade 1 since January 2016. Contextualization of these lesson plans is being done in consultation with community elders and undergoes further validation with the community itself.
3. One consistent feedback from community elders and leaders, during consultations and workshops, was the need for deeper discussions on

customary governance processes. After seeing the contextualization process articulated during the curriculum contextualization training-workshops (rolled out in 15 regions), community representatives from several regions expressed the urgent need for IP youth to have a deeper grounding on their community's indigenous governance and justice system, and their role and contribution to the growth and development of their communities.

4. Guided by these feedback and suggestions from community elders, IPsEO looked at the K to 12 curriculum and recognized that Araling Panlipunan is a key subject area that can be effectively contextualized to deepen discussion on a community's customary governance and justice system since such concepts and related concerns are the focus of the subject. This subject is also contextualized by design with every grade focusing on a particular scope of 'community', and this scope widens as one progresses through the grade levels. This schema of widening community context matches the concrete realities of indigenous learners who are envisioned to be rooted and grounded in their community's history, culture and realities while developing the capacity to effectively interact with wider Philippine society.
5. Aligned with the thrust to further support the contextualization of Araling Panlipunan, the subject training-workshop shall gather the supervisors in-charge of Araling Panlipunan and the Regional and Division IPEd Focal Persons for guided technical discussions on Araling Panlipunan curriculum contextualization for schools with IP learners.
6. During the training-workshop, the participants are expected to:
 - a) identify standards in the Araling Panlipunan Curriculum Guide that can be enhanced in relation to the worldview and context of IP communities
 - b) refine the process of developing indigenized lesson plans in Araling Panlipunan
 - c) gain and develop the competencies needed to guide the contextualization of Araling Panlipunan in schools with IP learners.
