Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao Events for the 2015 Regional Festival of Talents Guidelines/ Mechanics/ Criteria

A. BIBLE VERSE READING AND INTERPRETATION

Mechanics:

- 1. Each division is entitled to send one (1) contestant.
- 2. Contestants will be on stage / judging area one at a time. Each contestant will be given three (3) minutes preparation time and three (3) minutes to deliver his statements /interpretation.
- 3. The Bible Verse/s shall be given on the spot by the Board of Judges. Contestants magnitude other Bible Verses during the delivery phase to support his/her statements or interpretation.
- 4. The decision of the Board of Judges is final and irrevocable.

Criteria for Judging:

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Content	- 50%
* Logic	- 25%
* Appropriateness of Examples	- 25%
Delivery	- 50%
* Grammar & Syntax	- 20%
* Consistency of style/Level of Language	- 20%
* Non Verbal Communication	- 10%
(gesture, movement, facial expressions, ar	nd eye contact with the audience)

B. CHARACTER ROLE PLAY ON FILIPINO VALUES

- * Each team shall consist of five (5-10) participants.
- * A picture which portrays an unfinished negative situation will be given for each team to plan and enact a one – scene resolution onstage depicting a Filipino value or some Filipino values
- * One (1) hour is given for each team to rehearse their conversations and role play. No coach is allowed to enter the rehearsal area.
- * Participants may use props.
- * Actual performance time (including entrance and exit) 5-8 minutes

The criteria for judging :

Content / Substance of characters' conversations	- 25%
Understanding of Role and Interpretation	
(Accurate resolution to the given situation)	- 25%
Spontaneity and Creativity	
(ability to act /react within the story)	- 25%
Continuity and Fluidity	
(conversation occurs naturally and consistent)	-25%
Overall performance	- 100%
