- 1.  - b. Enhance knowledge of private educational institutions on the Enhanced Basic Education Information System (EBEIS), Learner Information System (LIS), Learner Reference Number (LRN), School Identification Number;
 - c. Provide updates on the K to 12 Program implementation and Assessment in relation to private school operations;
 - d. Provide updates on DepEd Programs and Projects, and;
 - e. Discuss the School Child Protection Policy (D. O. No. 40, s. 2012 and anti-bullying Anti bullying policy;
 - 3. Participants to attend the said summit as determined for the Schools Division of Digos City is 17. List of confirmed participants from the SDOs specifically from the Private Schools shall be submitted to the Regional Office, attention: Quality Assurance Division. Thus, all Public Schools District Supervisors are enjoined to facilitate the confirmation of attendance of private schools to the summit, under its supervision, on or before November 20, 2017.

 - 6. Reiterating also to the Public Schools District Supervisors, the submission of Quarterly Monitoring Tool for private schools not later than December 15, 2017.
