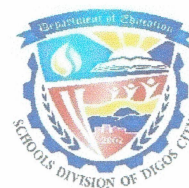

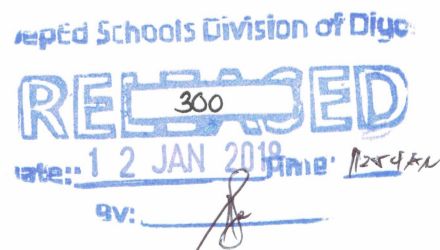

**ENHANCEMENT OF IPED FRAMEWORK/VALIDATION OF THE IPED FRAMEWORK
DRAFT WITH THE COMMUNITY**

EPSs, PSDSs, SHs and Teachers Concerned

1. The DepEd Digos City Division and the IP's ICC's (Bagobo – Tagabawa Tribe) completed the formulation of its IPEd Program Framework in the second quarter of 2015 and the document will be launched for multiple classroom use in the last quarter of 2016. However, while the document actualizes the legal mandates to address a culture-responsive education, the framework also needs enhancement to consider more opportunities for contextualizing education planning processes in harmonizing DepEd Knowledge System with the Indigenous Learning System (ILS).
2. Towards this end the DepEd Digos City Division shall conduct a one-day enhancement of IPEd framework/validation of IPEd framework draft on January 20, 2018 at Arnaldo's Hotel, Rizal Ave., Digos City.
3. Participants are expected to be at the venue at exactly eight o'clock in the morning. (List of Participants is found in the enclosure.)
4. Travel, meals and other incidental expenses of the participants shall be charged to IPED Program Support Fund (PSF) 2016. DepEd participants shall earn one Compensatory Overtime Credit for Non-Teaching Personnel and one Service Credit for Teaching Personnel (per DO 53, 2003 and CSC DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004).
5. Immediate dissemination of and compliance of this Memorandum is desired.
