**Conduct of the Three-Day Training on Assessment  
for Teachers and CID Personnel**

1. In pursuance to DepEd Order No. 8, s. 2015, re: Policy Guidelines on Classroom Assessment for the K to 12 Basic Education Program, and in connection with the initiative of the Division in unifying quarterly assessments, a Three-Day Training on Assessment for Teachers and CID Personnel shall be conducted from January 31-February 2, 2018 at the Nakayama Convention Center, Bonifacio-Bataan St., Aplaya, Digos City.
2. The objectives of the training are as follows:
  - a. To deepen participants' understanding/knowledge on:
    - a.1 Basic Principles of Assessment
    - a.2 Assessment Framework (DepEd Order No. 8, s. 2015)
    - a.3 Test Item Construction
    - a.4 Electronic Assessment Results Recording
  - b. To enhance participants' skills on formulating test questions through workshops and paneling
  - c. To finalize test questions for 4<sup>th</sup> quarter examinations
3. The participants in this training are the CID Chief, the Education Program Supervisors, the Public Schools District Supervisors, and the identified test writers enumerated in the attached List of Teacher-Participants, with the assistance of the HRD Personnel.
4. Focal persons in all learning areas are reminded to ensure the availability of test questions for 4<sup>th</sup> quarter examinations, in soft copy, submitted by all test writers per level and per learning area, to be finalized during the training.
5. Identified teacher-participants must also ensure that they have in their custody a soft copy of test questions for the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter examinations to be used during the training. They are advised to bring their laptops, too.
6. Travel expenses and participants' registration of One Thousand Fourteen Pesos (Php 1,014.00)/head for three (3) days shall be charged against the School MOOE for teacher-participants, and to Division INSET Funds for Division personnel.
