SUBJECT : TURN-OVER OF QUALIFIED ATHLETES TO THE TRAINING VENUE FOR TRAINING OF THE DAVAO ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION (DAVRAA) QUALIFIED ATHLETES, COACHES AND CHAPERONS TO THE 2016 PALARONG PAMBANSA

DATE : March 3, 2016

1. As per Regional Memorandum No.47 s, 2016, the Training of the Davao Athletic Association (DAVRAA) Qualified Athletes, Coaches and Chaperons to the 2016 Palarong Pambansa will be from March 1, 2016 up to April 3, 2016.
2. Considering the fact that the financial subsidy by the DepEd Central Office does not include an item for training, the DepEd Regional Office deems it necessary to have a modified training of athletes to be held at the different training venues except for Athletics which has an assembled training at Davao del Norte Sports and Tourism Center, Tagum City.
3. The following qualified /non-winning DAVRAA Coaches shall take charge in the turn-over of athletes to their training venues, to wit:

4. The assigned coaches shall only turn-over the athletes to their official Palaro Coaches and shall return to their official stations as soon as the task is accomplished.
5. Travel expenses of coaches including incidental expenses in going to and from the venues shall be charged against Local/School MOOE funds, all subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
6. Immediate dissemination and compliance with this Memorandum is desired.
