

Tambayan Center for Children's Rights Incorporated in partnership with Lunâ Legai Resource Center will be implementing a two year USAID-funded project entitled Countering Trafficking in Person through Information Sharing, Training, Education and Responsive Governance (Counter-TIPSTER) in Barangays Zone II and Zone III, Digos City.

The project generally aims to contribute in the reduction of incidence of trafficking in persons (TIP) in this city owing to the growing regional, national and global concern on TIP and children on the move. Among the project's main activities are capacity-building of Barangay Local Government Unit (BLGU) officials and stakeholders and the formation of Barangay Inter-Agency Council Against Trafficking (BIACAT) as mandated by R.A. 10364 or the Expanded Anti-Trafficking in Persons Act of 2012.

From December 2015 to January 2016, the project launched the Participatory Action Research (PAR) which will serve as baseline for our future intervention against trafficking in person (TIP) in southern Mindanao. During this period, our team conducted Key Informant Interviews and Focus Group Discussions in the six (6) target barangays in the cities of Davao, Digos and General Santos.

In line with this, we will be presenting the results/findings conduct of the research in Arnaldos Hotel, Rizal Ave., Digos City on April 14, 2016 from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon. This activity hopes to generate candid comments on the findings and recommendations from you and the community to improve the research report and the project.
