

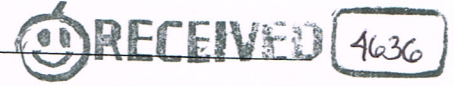

Further, it is reiterated that the attendance of the pupils and students during the conduct of the activity is purely voluntary in nature and that there is parental consent.

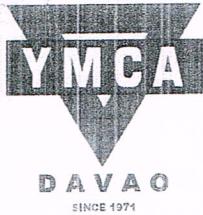
