1. In compliance with Regional Memorandum No. 181, s. 2016 re: Regional Training on Early Language, Literacy, and Numeracy, Digos City Division sends the participants named on the attached list for Batch 1 and 2, which will be conducted on September 10, 2016 to September 19, 2016 (for Batch 1) and on September 21, 2016 to September 29, 2016 (for Batch 2), venue of the two schedules will be announced later.

2. The objectives of the regional training are the following;

- a.) reinforce the capacity of Kinder to Grade 3 teachers to teach and assess early reading and numeracy skills;
- b.) strengthen the skills of school heads as instructional managers and supervisors; and
- c.) improve management and administration of the program (i.e. planning, operations, action research, sharing, and implementing best practices, monitoring and networking).
- 3. School Heads are advised to bring portable Hard Drive Disk or Laptop (with still more spaces) for the storage of videos to be used in their respective school-based training program. School Heads are also advised to assign an Officer-In-Charge who will look after the school in times of their attendance to the said training and classes of those teachers attending the ten-day training should also be arranged in such a way that teachers who will attend the training will prepare activities for the class enough for the duration to be supervised by a teachers who will be assigned to take charge of the class.
- 4. Participants shall be granted with Compensatory Overtime Credits (COC) for attending training dates that fall on Saturdays, Sundays, and Holidays.
- 5. Food, accommodation, training resource materials, traveling expenses of the trainers shall be charged to 2016 ECARP Funds, while traveling expenses are chargeable against local funds all subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 12, s. 2015, entitled "Guidelines on the Early Language, Literacy, and Numeracy Program: Professional Development Components" DepEd Region XI will conduct a Regional Training on Early Language, Literacy and Numeracy on September 10-19, 2016 (Batch 1) and on September 21-30, 2016(Batch 2). Venue to be announced later.
- 2. The Program will develop the Filipino children literacy and numeracy skills and attitudes which will contribute to lifelong learning. More specifically, it aims to improve reading and numeracy skills of Kinder to Grade 3 pupils following the K to 12 Basic Education Curriculum, and to establish a sustainable and cost-effective professional development system for teachers.
- 3. The objectives of this training are the following:
 - a) reinforce the capacity of kinder to Grade 3 teachers to teach and assess early reading and numeracy skills;
 - b) strengthen the skills of school heads as instructional managers and supervisors; and
 - c) improve management and administration of the program (i.e. planning, operations, action research, sharing, and implementing best practices, monitoring and networking).
