- 2. In line with DepEd's goal of active community involvement, you are hereby directed to make the necessary preparations to attend the activity on July 1, 2017. The school heads and teachers involved are to instruct the students to prepare the needed props (gold flaglets) and to secure parent's consent for their attendance since the activity falls on a Saturday. Teachers and students shall be required to wear their uniforms and IDs for security purposes.
- 3. Principals involved are advised to make the necessary arrangements with the teachers to ensure that pupil's safety will be given enough attention.
- 4. At 7:00 AM on July 1, 2017, involved teachers and pupils are expected to have assembled themselves along the national highway adjacent to their schools carrying the gold flaglets to welcome the participants of the Motorcade/Civic Parade.
- 5. School heads and teachers attending the activity shall earn one COC/Service Credit (As per DO 53, series of 2003) provided attendance and proper documentation is secured.
