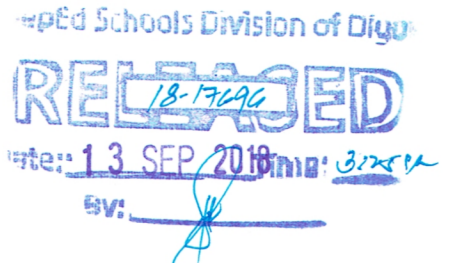

Mechanics and Guidelines Criteria for Judging

1. The contest is open to all public school teachers whether individual or group (8-10 members only).
2. Each district/school should have one (1) entry.

1. Mt. Apo
2. Digos Oriental
3. Digos Occidental
4. Digos South
5. DiCNHS

3. Any talent may do as long as Items 4, 5 and 6 are strictly followed.
4. No acrobatics and no pyramid are allowed.
5. The use of combustible materials is not allowed.
6. No vulgar rude and improper costumes and choreography in the whole duration of performance.
7. The allotted time is 3-5 minutes only including the entrance and exit.
8. The contestant/s shall bring their own props and musical accompaniments.
9. The decision of the judges is final and irrevocable.

Entertainment Quality/Wow! Factor	50%
Audience Appeal	25%
