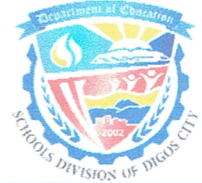

4. For information, guidance and compliance.

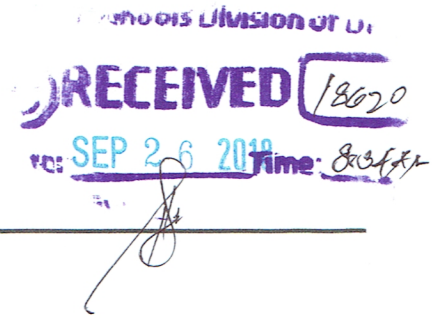


Greetings!
