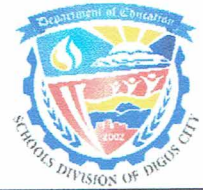

1. Pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 1906, series of 2009, **October is declared as the "National Indigenous Peoples Month"**. The theme for this year's celebration is aligned with the National IP Month Celebration which is **"Karunungan ng Katutubong Pamayanan Paigtingin: Pundasyon ng Katutubong Edukasyon"**. In observance of, and in solidarity with the Indigenous Cultural Communities of Digos City, the City Schools Division of Digos will hold the **2019 Panaghiusa Festival on December 6, 2019, 8:00AM to 5:00PM, and shall be hosted by Digos City National High School.**
2. The one-day festival aims to showcase the different tribal games and Indigenous Knowledge Systems and Practices (IKSPs) of the IP Elders and learners in Digos City.

4. Teachers and students from **IPEd implementing schools** from each district (Digos Occidental, Digos Oriental, Digos South, and Mount Apo) are enjoined to **present one authentic tribal/IP dance while other participating schools are enjoined to present an IP inspired dance number.**
5. The **participating schools shall prepare entries for the tribal games and showcase of IKSPs with the assistance of their IP Elders.** (See enclosure for the guidelines.)
6. Enclosed is the complete list of the participants including the school heads and IP teachers who are not under the participating schools but are members of the 2019 Division Panaghiusa Festival Working Committees. Participants are encouraged to wear their tribal dress or IP inspired dress.
7. Meals and snacks of the participants and travel expenses of the IP Elders shall be charged against IPEd PSF 2019 while travel and incidental expenses of participants from the division and schools shall be charged against local funds/school MOOE subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
