- 2. Free Blood Sugar Screening and BP;
- 3. Activity hand-outs, meals, gift packs; and
- 4. Transportation allowance of equivalent to P500.00 per participant to cover transportation to and from CHET event venue

Stage 2 of the campaign is the school caravan on the selected 40 secondary schools all over the region to which will commence on February 17, 2020. The target audience are female students (minimum of 1, 500/school), parents and teachers. The event will be done 60 minutes per school and 2 schools per day. 
