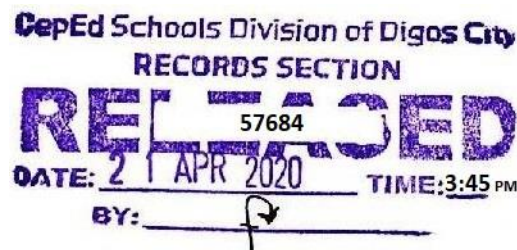

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A. ENVIRONMENTAL COMIC HEROES DESIGN CONTEST

Objective:

It is a competition to create a set of Environmental Comic Heroes to be used in the environmental awareness campaign of the EMB

How to participate:

The Environmental Comic Heroes Design Contest is open to all (Nationwide).

1. The Participant can submit entries to all of the Five (5) Environmental Comic Heroes but limited only to one (1) entry per Comic Hero per participant.
2. The Participant must submit a name entry per Comic Hero (English or Taglish). The Design of the Environmental Comic Heroes must revolve around the following background:

Environmental Comic Heroes to be designed:

- Hero 1: Design pertains to Air

- Submission must contain the scanned free hand design / electronic copies of the layered design in digital format either Adobe Illustrator, Photoshop, Corel Draw/Paint or Macromedia Freehand format.
 - The design must have 1800 x 1200 pixels at 300 dpi (Resolution)
