ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS AND INSTRUCTIONS FOR PRIVATE LEARNING INSTITUTIONS APPLYING FOR GOVERNMENT PERMITS FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2020-2021

 Pursuant to Regional Memorandum No. 22, s. 2020 titled Additional Requirements and Instructions for Private Learning Institutions Applying for Government Permits for School Year 2020-2021 and Regional Memorandum No. 24, s. 2020 titled Amendment to Regional Memorandum 22, s. 2020, this Office informs the field on the compliance of additional requirements by the Regional Office stipulated in Item no. 8 of DepEd Order 007, s. 2020 or the School Calendar and Activities for School Year 2020-2021 which states:

"Private Schools and state/local universities and colleges (SUCs/LUCs) offering basic education will be allowed to open classes within the period authorized by RA 7797, which is on the first Monday of June but not later than the last day of August, provided:

- a. No face-to-face classes will be allowed earlier than August 24, 2020 and from then on, face-to-face classes may be conducted only in areas allowed to open physically.
- b. They submit in advance the following documents to the Schools Division Office (SDO) for review and monitoring purposes, three (3) weeks before the opening of classes or earlier:
 - Their school's plan for compliance with the minimum health standards that will be issued by DepEd, the DOH, the IATF and the Office of the President (OP);
 - ii. Their School's Learning Continuity Plan showing alternative Delivery Modes of learning when face-to-face learning is not allowed, which shall constitute compliance with the requirement provided under Item 6 of Annex 3, DepEd Order 021, s. 2019; and
 - iii. Their schools SY 2020-2021 School Calendar;

SDO shall ascertain whether submitted documents are in consonance with existing policies and guidelines of the DepEd, the DOH, the IATF and the Office of the President (OP);

1. Item no. 3 of Regional Memorandum 22, s. 2020 is hereby amended as follows:

> For purposes of clarity, all documents specifically stipulated in item No. 1, letter B are to be submitted first by private educational institutions to the concerned Schools-Division Offices (SDOs) for review and monitoring purposes, three (3) weeks before the opening of classes or earlier.

SDOs shall ascertain whether submitted documents are in consonance with existing policies and guidelines of the DepEd, the DOH, the IATF and the Office of the President (OP).

Concerned SDO through the Schools Division Superintendent shall indorse said documents to the Office of the Regional Director along with a narrative report detailing findings and recommendations two (2) weeks before the opening of classes of the concerned private school.

- All other provisions of the said Memorandum remain in effect.

In view of the national health emergency brought about by the COVID 19 pandemic and its effects to education, this Regional Office directs compliance from all concerned to the instructions stipulated in Item no. 8 of DepEd Order 007, s. 2020 or the School Calendar and Activities for School Year 2020-2021 which states:

"Private Schools and state/local universities and colleges (SUCs/LUCs) offering basic education will be allowed to open classes within the period authorized by RA 7797, which is on the first Mondayof June but not later than the last day of August, Provided:

- a. No face-to-face classes will be allowed earlier than August 24, 2020 and from then on, face-to-face classes may be conducted only in areas allowed to open physically.
- b. They submit in advance the following documents to the DepEd Regional Offices (ROs) for review and monitoring purposes:
 - i. Their school's plan for compliance with minimum health standards that will be issued by DepEd, consistent with guidelines of the DOH, the IATF and the OP;

- ii. Their School's Learning Continuity Plan showing alternative Delivery modes of learning when face-to-face learning is not allowed, which shall constitute compliance with the requirement provided under Item 6 of Annex 3, DepEd Order 021, s. 2019; and
- iii. Their school's SY 2020-2021 School Calendar.
- 2. It is emphasized that submission and subsequent approval of the above-cited documents are considered additional requirements for the issuance of permits by this Regional Office.
