

Some general information related to the conduct of SEAQiM Regular Course 2021 is as follows:

A. Duration

Each regular course runs for 100 hours, @45 minutes, which is around 10 days (weekdays).

B. Mode

SEAQiM 2021's regular course is to be conducted virtually via Zoom and Learning Management System (LMS) platform, such as Moodle and Google Classroom.

The proportion of online learning is provided below:

- Learning via Zoom : 50%
- Learning via LMS : 50%

C. Tentative Schedule

The tentative schedule will be informed to the participants approximately one week before the beginning of each regular course.

D. Language Delivery

Instruction will be delivered in English.

E. Facilitator

The participants will be facilitated by SEAQiM Academic Team, and some invited experts in mathematics education from some reputable institutions worldwide.

F. Certificate

The participants will be awarded a Certificate of Participation following the rules and conditions applied by SEAQiM.

G. Cost

SEAQiM's regular course is free of charge.

H. Internet Quota

Each participant is responsible for supporting any cost to support his/her own internet quota during the regular course.
