Eligibility

Participants must be officially enrolled elementary or secondary who learners. Only those register through http://bit.ly/WED2021events before the date/deadline of activity, shall be considered as official contestants.

I. Quiz Bee Guidelines:

This event will be conducted on June 1, 2021 at 2:00 PM. Registered contestant must have a device (Android Phone or Laptop) to access the link of the website/activity platform, which will be sent by the TWG to his/her registered email address.

There will be 20 questions that must be answered by the contestants within the allotted time. Three (3) contestants with highest final score will be declared as winners for the event.

II. Poster and Slogan Making Guidelines:

Participants shall use a 1/2 Illustration board as canvass and may use ANY of the following basic drawing and coloring materials: crayons, oil pastels, coloring pencils, watercolors, poster paints and markers.

The artwork shall follow a PORTRAIT orientation and shall not bear any mark or text identifying the owner of the artwork. The TWG will give a corresponding entry number for each artwork upon submission. Entries must be submitted to the Division Youth Formation Coordinator in the Division Office not later than 10:00 AM on June 3, 2021.

Entries will be judged using the criteria below:

Relevance to the theme – 40%

Creativity and originality – 30%

Overall presentation – 20%

Online reactions – "like" and "heart" – 10%

III. Spoken Poetry:

Each entry must only be 60-90 seconds duration. It must be submitted through email joseisrael.maravilles@deped.gov.ph not later than June 3, 2021 (Thursday) 10:00AM, with the subject containing the following: (DISTRICT_SCHOOL_NAME). Video must be in LANDSCAPE orientation.

Entries will be judged using the criteria below:

Message and Content - 40%

Delivery and Performance - 40%

Originality – 10%

Overall impact – 10%

Selection and announcement of winners

A panel of judges will convene on June 3, 2021 to evaluate the entries submitted before the deadline set in this memorandum. For Poster & Slogan Making and Spoken Poetry, the judges will select top 3 entries for both elementary and secondary categories based on the given criteria above and will be announced on June 4, 2021 during the celebration. LATE ENTRIES WILL NO LONGER BE ACCEPTED.
