**CONDUCT OF THE BRIDGING ACTIVITIES FOR KINDERGARTEN LEARNERS**

ATTENTION: Kindergarten Teachers

1. In pursuance to the herein attached Regional Memorandum dated August 4, 2021, re: Conduct of the Bridging Activities for Kindergarten Learners, this office requires all schools to conduct bridging activities to cater those kindergarten learners who are not yet ready or still need to master the competencies across developmental domains based on the results of the post assessment conducted at the end of School Year 2020-2021.
2. The bridging activities shall be conducted in August to September 2021 before the opening of classes for SY 2021 -2022. This is to ensure that the incoming Grade I entrants are ready and equipped with the skills expected of them.
3. The schools are expected to set their own schedule, the daily activities to undertake, the learning materials, and the kind of modules in order to deliver and implement the said program compliant to the health protocol and restriction of the Local Government Units against COVID –19. Thus, each elementary school is required to submit to this office an Action Plan on the Conduct of Bridging Activities, with list of teachers to do the task, as early as possible. They are also expected to submit an Accomplishment Report after the conduct of the bridging activities.
4. This office will grant a one-day Service Credit to the teachers who will be involved in the implementation of this activity for every 8-hour accumulated services rendered based on DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 or the Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers subject in the existing CSC – DBM Joint Circular No 2. S.2004 on non-monetary remuneration for the overtime services rendered.
5. All schools implementing this bridging activities for kindergarten learners must submit weekly report using the template provided by the Division Office.
6. All expenses relative to the implementation of the Bridging Activities shall be charged to local fund /School MOOE subject the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

Subject: CONDUCT OF BRIDGING ACTIVITIES  
FOR KINDERGARTEN LEARNERS

Date : August 4, 2020

In reference to DepEd Order No. 47, s. 2016 or better known as Omnibus Policy on Kindergarten Education, the Philippine Early Childhood Development (ECD) Checklist has been administered to all kindergarten learners in public schools.

As the Philippine ECD Checklist provides significant information about a child's developmental status and aids the teacher in detecting possible developmental delays, this Office advises the Schools Division Offices (SDOs) to conduct bridging activities to cater those kindergarten learners who are not yet Ready or they still need to master the competencies across developmental domains based on the results of the post assessment conducted at the end of School Year 2020-2021.

The bridging activities shall be conducted in August to September, 2021 before the opening of classes for SY 2021-2022. This is to ensure that the incoming Grade 1 entrants are ready and equipped with the skills expected from them.

The SDOs are encouraged to set their own schedule, the daily activities to undertake, the learning materials, and the kind of modalities in order to deliver and implement the said program compliant to the health protocol and restriction of the Local Government Units (LGUs) against COVID-19.

This Office grants Service Credits/Compensatory Overtime Credits to the teachers and education leaders who are involved in the implementation of this activity for the services they rendered based on DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 or the Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers subject to the existing CSC and CSC-DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 or non-monetary remuneration for the overtime services rendered.

All expenses relative to the implementation of the Bridging Activities shall be charged against local funds subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
