

- The Department of Education (DepEd) through the Bureau of Learning Delivery (BLD issues this interim Guidelines on the Utilization of Program Support Funds for Special Education (SPED) for FY 2021.
- 2. These interim guidelines are in lieu of the upcoming DepEd Order on the utilization of SPED Program support fund. It shall guide concerned DepEd officials to ensure effective and efficient utilization of the SPED program support fund (SPED-PSF).
- 3. For FY 2021, public elementary and secondary schools with 20 and above enrolment of Learners with Disability in every Schools Division Offices from the sixteen (16) regions except Bangsamoro Autonomous Region of Muslim Mindanao (BARMM) by virtue of the Republic Act No. 11054 "Organic Law for the BARMM" shall receive the program support fund on top of the regular MOOE of the schools. The list of recipient schools with the corresponding amount is found in annex A. Schools with less than 20 LWD enrolment may use the regular MOOE to support programs and activities for learners with disabilities.
- 4. The recipient schools shall submit to the Schools Division Superintendent their respective Annual Implementation Plan (AIP) which contain activities for the SPED Program for approval based on the eligible items of expenditures.
- 5. Upon issuance of these interim guidelines, and the subsequent issuances of Sub-AROs of the SPED PSF, the Regional Offices (ROs) shall communicate to the Schools Division Offices (SDOs) regarding the availability of funds and the need to prepare the Work and Financial Plan (WFP) through the Program

Management Information System (PMIS) based on the approved AIP of the recipient schools.

- 6. The RO-Policy Planning and Research Division (PPRD) in coordination with the Regional Supervisor in-charge of the SPED program shall endorse the submitted SDO-approved physical and financial plan and the list of recipient schools to the RO-Finance Division for the release of the PSF.
- 7. The PSF of the schools shall be used, among others, to provide support to the educational services of LWDs in public elementary and secondary schools with SPED Program through the:
  - 7.1 Formal assessment or rehabilitation of LWDs by Medical or Allied Medical specialists;
  - 7.2 Acquisition of specialized materials, devices and equipment that are intended for Instructional Purposes of Learners with Disability/Difficulty instructional purposes provided that the amount do not exceed Php15,000.00;
  - 7.3 Attendance of SPED teachers and receiving teachers and other concerned school personnel in specialized trainings on inclusive and special education conducted by NEAP accredited service providers;
  - 7.4 Immersion of LWDs to different work industry for possible employment and their participation to sports, academic and co curricular activities toward holistic development; and
  - 7.5 Communication expenses of SPED implementers subject to reimbursement and/or liquidation and existing DepEd policy on communication expense.
- 8. The Schools Division Offices (SDOs) shall also receive a PSF depending on the number of schools with SPED program to be used to augment the expenses related to (a) monitoring and evaluation of the SPED Program in their respective Schools Division; (b) attendance and conduct of training on inclusive and special education programs; (c) Advocacy Programs for inclusive and special education; and (d) other expenses related to the implementation of the SPED Program.

- The Department of Education (DepEd) through the Bureau of Learning Delivery (BLD issues this interim Guidelines on the Utilization of Program Support Funds for Special Education (SPED) for FY 2021.
- 2. These interim guidelines are in lieu of the upcoming DepEd Order on the utilization of SPED Program support fund. It shall guide concerned DepEd officials to ensure effective and efficient utilization of the SPED program support fund (SPED-PSF).
- 3. For FY 2021, public elementary and secondary schools with 20 and above enrolment of Learners with Disability in every Schools Division Offices from the sixteen (16) regions except Bangsamoro Autonomous Region of Muslim Mindanao (BARMM) by virtue of the Republic Act No. 11054 "Organic Law for the BARMM" shall receive the program support fund on top of the regular MOOE of the schools. The list of recipient schools with the corresponding amount is found in annex A. Schools with less than 20 LWD enrolment may use the regular MOOE to support programs and activities for learners with disabilities.
- 4. The recipient schools shall submit to the Schools Division Superintendent their respective Annual Implementation Plan (AIP) which contain activities for the SPED Program for approval based on the eligible items of expenditures.
- 5. Upon issuance of these interim guidelines, and the subsequent issuances of Sub-AROs of the SPED PSF, the Regional Offices (ROs) shall communicate to the Schools Division Offices (SDOs) regarding the availability of funds and the need to prepare the Work and Financial Plan (WFP) through the Program

Management Information System (PMIS) based on the approved AIP of the recipient schools.

- 6. The RO-Policy Planning and Research Division (PPRD) in coordination with the Regional Supervisor in-charge of the SPED program shall endorse the submitted SDO-approved physical and financial plan and the list of recipient schools to the RO-Finance Division for the release of the PSF.
- 7. The PSF of the schools shall be used, among others, to provide support to the educational services of LWDs in public elementary and secondary schools with SPED Program through the:
  - 7.1 Formal assessment or rehabilitation of LWDs by Medical or Allied Medical specialists;
  - 7.2 Acquisition of specialized materials, devices and equipment that are intended for Instructional Purposes of Learners with Disability/Difficulty instructional purposes provided that the amount do not exceed Php15,000.00;
  - 7.3 Attendance of SPED teachers and receiving teachers and other concerned school personnel in specialized trainings on inclusive and special education conducted by NEAP accredited service providers;
  - 7.4 Immersion of LWDs to different work industry for possible employment and their participation to sports, academic and co - curricular activities toward holistic development; and
  - 7.5 Communication expenses of SPED implementers subject to reimbursement and/or liquidation and existing DepEd policy on communication expense.
- 8. The Schools Division Offices (SDOs) shall also receive a PSF depending on the number of schools with SPED program to be used to augment the expenses related to (a) monitoring and evaluation of the SPED Program in their respective Schools Division; (b) attendance and conduct of training on inclusive and special education programs; (c) Advocacy Programs for inclusive and special education; and (d) other expenses related to the implementation of the SPED Program.
