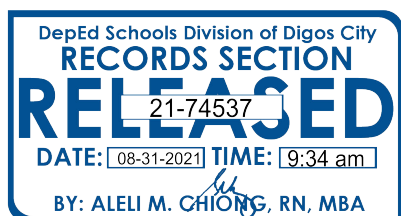

1. Pursuant to the OUA Memo 00-0821-0112 dated August 9, 2021 and in accordance with the DepEd Memorandum No. 234, s. 2008, "Planting of Malunggay Trees in Schools," all school administrators are encouraged to support the planting of malunggay or moringa trees in school premises and communities through integration in science classes and school community outreach projects.

This initiative will be part of the proposed project of the Inter-Agency Task Force Zero Hunger (IATFZH) to intensify the collaboration of different agencies and promote the use of malunggay or moringa as a source of livelihood and nutrition. 
