

Endorsements from the head of office* a. endorsement from the Schools Division Office through the Office of the SDS b. Statement of PRESENT Actual Duties and Responsibilities signed by the immediate supervisor - 1 original, 1 certified copy

For the purpose of the initial screening of NEAP, the **Participant Nomination Form and scanned copy of the required documents with asterisks** must be submitted via email at scholarships@deped.gov.ph on or before **August 12, 2021**. Shortlisted applicants will undergo further evaluation to be conducted by UP Diliman – College of Education. The other documents must be ready for submission by **August 19, 2021** through scholarships@deped.gov.ph.

Please take note that the Scholarship Screening Committee may contact the applicants to validate the authenticity and integrity of the documents submitted and to gather additional information, if needed.
