2021 BRIGADA ESKWELA IMPLEMENTING GUIDELINES

- To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent
Chiefs, CID and SGOD

Public Schools District Supervisors
Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads
1. Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum No. 48, 2021 and Regional Memorandum 49, 2021 attached herein, the Schools Division Office sets forth the guidelines for implementing Brigada Eskwela 2021 in the Division.
 2. The national slogan for this year's Brigada Eskwela is "Bayanihan Para sa Paaralan" while the Region XI theme is "Handang Paaralan Para sa Handang Pasukan".
 3. All Brigada Eskwela activities shall strictly adhere to safety and health protocols issued by the Local Government Unit. The participation of volunteers shall take into account the guidelines on social distancing and the capacity of the school depending on the prevailing classification (ECQ, MECQ, GCQ, MGCQ).
 4. The maintenance activities shall commence on August 3, until September 30, 2021. Teachers shall be entitled to one-day service credit for every accumulated eight hours of participation in the Brigada Eskwela effort. The maximum number of days to be earned during the entire Brigada period is 10 days.
 5. Schools are encouraged to have a Kick-Off activity to highlight advocacy for Brigada Eskwela in their schools and enjoin partners and volunteers to participate. The Division Kick-Off shall be done on August 25, 2021 via virtual mode.
 6. The division evaluation and monitoring team shall be composed of the following personnel shall ensure the smooth conduct of the Brigada Eskwela 2021 implementation. The same personnel shall form part of the evaluators for the 2021 Brigada Eskwela Search for Best Implementing Schools:

7. School heads shall take the lead in partnership efforts under the Adopt-A-School Program Framework. Partnerships shall focus on resources in support of the BE-LCP and the schools' maintenance needs.
8. The partnership guidelines, WINs guidelines, and safety preparedness guide are contained in the attached documents. The criteria and mechanics for the search for best implementing schools are also contained therein.
9. A weekly reporting of resources and volunteers must be done online thru the link: <https://tinyurl.com/BE2021Weekly>.
10. The Public Schools District Supervisors shall select their District Entries to the Division Level which shall be evaluated by the committee composed above. Official School Entries shall prepare and submit their Brigada Eskwela Portfolio with District Indorsement and 5-minute video for perusal by the evaluators during the school validation visit. Deadline for the submission of Brigada Eskwela Accomplishment Reports and Portfolio for the Best Implementing School shall be on October 15, 2021.
