Subject: SUBMISSION OF REPORT ON THE UNVACCINATED EMPLOYEES

Date : August 10, 2021

The government is currently in the initial phase of vaccine rollout with the availability of Sinovac, AstraZeneca, Pfizer, Janssen, Sputnik V and Moderna vaccines in the country. The national government is closely working in partnership with the local governments in providing vaccination to Priority Groups A1, A2 and A3, covering the DepEd health personnel and employees who are senior citizens and who have co-morbidities. Some LGUs are in preparation stage in covering Priority Group A4, which includes our DepEd personnel. While some are already in the implementation of the vaccine rollout for the remaining DepEd teaching and non-teaching personnel.

In view thereof, this Office requires all Schools Division Offices to track and report all the unvaccinated employees using the attached sample format if already done with the vaccine rollout to Priority Group A4, covering all the remaining DepEd personnel not covered in the vaccine rollout to Priority Groups A1, A2 and A3, to be submitted to Education Support Services Division thru Mr. Stephen Mark T. Castros, Regional COVID-19 Focal Person via email: stephenmark.castros@deped.gov.ph.

In addition, all SDOs are required to update the Regional Google Sheets on the Vaccination Data weekly via bit.ly/COVID-19VaccinationData, providing accurate number of vaccinated personnel with first dose and second dose, and data on Adverse Events Following Immunization (AEFI).

Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
