

- 1. In reference to RM 058, s. 2021 entitled "Institutionalizing Pen-Pen Grading System as Standard Grading System for School Year 2021-2022 as the DepEd Region XI expresses its continued commitment to find ways to improve the provision of learning opportunities to all Filipino, this office relays to the field the recommendation of the Regional Office on the use of the pen-pen grading system as the standard grading system in the creation of Learners Progress Report Card (SF 9) and Learners Permanent Record (SF 10) except the IP Schools and Senior High Schools.
- 2. In connection thereof, the Public Schools District Supervisors are directed to have this concern discussed with all the School Heads in the District, with expected results as follows: 1) Identified the schools which should implement the system, and b) Set plan on how it should be adopted, implemented and monitored at the school level.

INSTITUTIONALIZING PEN- PEN GRADING SYSTEM AS STANDARD GRADING SYSTEM FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2021 - 2022

To Schools Division Superintendents

- Amid the continuing national public health emergency due to COVID 19, the DepEd Region 1. XI remains committed to find ways to improve the provision of learning opportunities to all Filipino learners for School Year 2021-2022. It also geared towards improving the basic delivery of education services to all teachers and learners particularly in the encoding of grades.
- To deliver fast, efficient, and accurate data of learners and to eliminate redundancies in the 2. encoding of grades, pen-pen is recommended to be the standard tool in the encoding of grades.
- 3. As such, all elementary and secondary public schools (including extension/annex schools) of this Region are encouraged to utilize the pen-pen as the standard grading system in the creation of learners Progress Report Card (SF 9) and Learners Permanent Record (SF 40) except the IP schools and Senior High Schools.
- 4. For more details, relative to this Regional Memorandum and the implementation of pen-pen grading system to schools and its regular monitoring of the program, please refer to the Policy Planning and Research Division (PPRD).
- Expenses incurred in the utilization of pen-pen grading system in schools shall be charged 5. against local school MOOE funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
